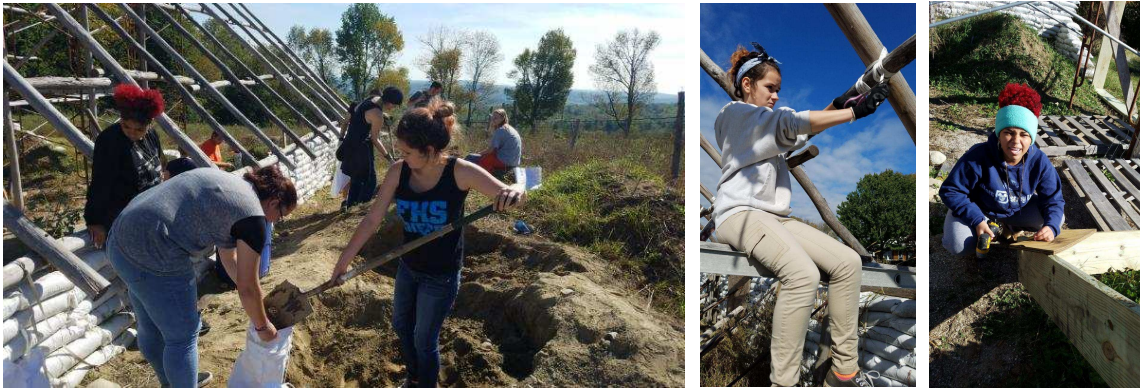


New Gloucester Campus updates
